




SEMINAR

CONCERT

Presidential Symphony Orchestra

The relationship between METU NCC and TRNC Presidential Symphony Orchestra, which was established in January 2015, dates back to even before the **mARTFest**. PSO, which is followed by great interest throughout the island, performs occasionally for Güzelyurt residents at METU NCC Campus.

The Presidential Symphony Orchestra, which aims to improve contemporary, polyphonic and universal musical culture on the island, includes the works of Cypriot composers as well as works of worldwide composers. The orchestra, which is one of the most distinguished components of the cultural and artistic environment of the island, will be hosted in the scope of our festival before their tour, which will take place on April 2-14, 2017 to Turkey.

WORKSHOP

Stick (wo)man



Stick(wo)man is a word game made up of man, woman and stick, and a project designed to create opportunities for women who have never made money during their lives. In the project, in addition to the yarn and the zipper, all previously used and discarded materials are used. This project, which has been created as a local development project in Ayvalık to focus on two important social problems such as

recycling and women's employment, aims to make packaging wastes tradeable by using creative, aesthetic and unique forms.

Within the scope of **mARTFest**, Tara Hopkins, the founder of the project, and Sıdıka Zincir and Aysun Kara, project developers, will carry out four workshops.

Dance society Activities

With the principle that 'Dance is the visible expression of music' the Dance Society, which has brought METU NCC and dance together for many years, is one of the most active and largest student societies on campus. This society, which enriches **mARTFest** with not only the dance shows, but also with workshops, will have special guests like Şenol Vefa Gülmez, Nur Özkan, Serdar Ömer and Ceren Öztunç.

The dance events, which will start with workshops to make you familiar with tango and salsa during daytime hours, will continue with the shows of some celebrated guests and well-known dancers of the island. This society invites you to discover yourself through music for two days.




WORKSHOP

Pottery with Savvas Pottery

Panikos Georgiades, who had a place in the art world with the Savvas Pottery brand, is a Cypriot potter who was born in Karavas in 1957. Georgiades, who returned to the island in 1988 after being trained in Germany,

 develops products with different colors and glazing techniques.

Within the scope of the **mARTFest**, the Panikos Georgiades will focus on how to create various pottery shapes. The workshop is open to anyone interested in the art of pottery!





WORKSHOP

Graffiti by Mr. Hure

Mr. Hure met graffiti in 1999 and is still actively painting. He has adopted 'the old-school style' since he started graffiti. After 2014, he started to do abstract works on walls other than graffiti. He has produced and worked on joint projects with many local and international brands. Graffiti, which was just a hobby initially became an integral part of his life over the years. The artist lives in Istanbul and continues his works there.

The artist, who has works in New York, Brooklyn and a mural in Miami, Wynwood, will be practicing at open-air workshops for four days on the campus.





SEMINAR, WORKSHOP

Adi Atassi

After leaving his country for education and being in different parts of the world, Adi Atassi, a Syrian artist who settled in Cyprus, describes himself as a 'multi-faceted existence, a creator and a collector of experiences'. Since 1987, he has been living and producing in Cyprus where as a result of being a foreigner, he experienced the loneliness that an artist needs. He also found the warmth and the passion to be creative thanks to the climate and cultural history of the island.

Atassi sums up his inspirational resources as 'the inner world of multi-faceted human existence, a beautiful poem, a pleasant film, an inspiring piece of music, all his personal experience hidden within him, various impressions that he got while searching for the purpose of life'. Expressing that his artistic production is realized in a breathtaking moment when he dives into his conscious and subconscious mind, the painter will take part both in the workshops which are open to everybody and the solo exhibitions at the **mARTFest**.





CONCERT

Violin Piano Duo

Can Özhan, the violonist, and Samir Mirzaev, the pianist, perform the most brilliant works of violin and piano repertoire in concerts under the name of "Violin Piano Duo". Receiving positive comments from listeners and music authorities, they perform concerts in Turkey and abroad in various countries.

The primary place in the repertoire of the duo belongs to J. Brahms, W. A. Mozart, L. v. Beethoven, N. Paganini and F. Liszt. We will host Can Özhan and Samir Mirzaev with a wonderful program that will enable the audience to 'witness the unique sounds of classical music' within the scope of the **mARTFest**.

The group is planning to start permanent projects by preserving their original band members and increase the quality of their music gradually.

The event will start with the piano recital of Emrah Sayın, who is one of the founders of the orchestra and is a piano teacher at the Dokuz Eylül University Conservatoire. A group of students from METU will also perform a short concert at the event.
